REPORT ON THE WORKING OF THE INDIAN SOCIETY FOR SPONSORSHIP AND ADOPTION FROM APRIL 2018 TO MARCH 2019

Mrs. Saroj Sood, Founder Hony. Secretary presents the 43rd Report on the working of The Indian Society for Sponsorship and Adoption for the period April 2018 to March 2019

The Adoption office continues to function from our Nava Jeevan Home. Our Head Office continues to be at Kyd Street. The Homes – Nava Jeevan and Nava Diganta continues to function with the help of the dedicated staff who have been with for us for some time. Both Homes have challenges which we have tried to deal with. We continue to receive many children from the Child Welfare Committees.

On the 1st of April 2018 we had a total of 47 children in our SAA Home, Nava Jeevan, of which 21 were male and 26 were female. Likewise, on the 1st of April 2018 we had a total of 46 female children in our Nava Diganta Home.

In the period April 2018 to March 2019 we received 56 children in Nava Jeevan Home of which 35 were girls and 21 were boys. There were 8 children who were restored to their families; 5 children were transferred to other Homes and other states and 2 children unfortunately died.

During the same period we received 297 girls in Nava Diganta Home, all of them were girls. Unfortunately 2 children ran away from Nava Diganta Home; 204 were restored to their families. There were 71 children who were transferred to other institutions from Nava Diganta Home.

On the 31st of March 2019, we had 55 children in our SAA Home, Nava Jeevan of which 31 were female and 24 were male. In our CCI Home, Nava Diganta Home we brought forward 66 female children.

ADOPTION PROGRAMME

Adoptions continue to be governed by the Central Adoption Resource Authority and Prospective Adoptive families are expected to register online on the CARINGS portal.

Prospective Adoptive Parents continue to choose us as a HSR Agency. We continue to use the SARA (State Adoption Resource Agency) appointed Social Workers. Home Study requests from other districts are being referred to State Adoption Resource Agency for transfer to a SAA of that district.

As a new initiative we started the Adoption Resource Centre at Nava Jeevan. We have a room which is dedicated to the waiting couples where we have put up posters to explain the adoption process. Literature on adoption is available for reading. Sample copies of the various schedules and forms that the prospective families are supposed to fill are printed and kept for study. Our team of Social Workers work with the prospective families in this room. Since the adoption process is completely online, we offer to register and upload the documents of the families who are not internet friendly. This effort is greatly appreciated by the families. Any families requiring pre adoption and post adoption counseling can be referred to our Resource Centre and we are committed to help the families who are referred to the Centre.

We continue to have a very large number of children at Nava Jeevan Home. Our caregivers, and other staff members are working tirelessly to look after the children under our care. We have under our care an average of 55 children at any given time. We thank the dedicated efforts of our Home staff who work round the clock with the children. Our Visiting doctors come once in 24 hours and look after the medical needs of the children. We also have a team coming in from the Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) to both our Homes. In spite of our best efforts we lost 2 children in the year at Dr. B.C. Roy Post Graduate Institute of Paediatric Sciences

NAVA DIGANTA HOME

Our Child Care Institute for girls, Nava Diganta continues to work tirelessly with for the girls of the age group of 6 to 18 years. Systems as per the provisions of the Integrated Child Protection Scheme (ICPS) are strictly adhered to. The Team at Nava Diganta Home is working hard to maintain discipline among the children. This proves to be quite a challenge. We keep them busy by

designing various activities throughout the day. The children who are of school going age and are with us for long term care are sent to the local school.

Our Vocational Training Unit is making different items, like paper bags, cards, and small items of costume jewellery. The Tailoring Unit is also helping the residents to learn items of use.

ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS

The 43rd Anniversary of the Society was celebrated on the 16th of December 2018. We hired the basement of Metropolitan Durgabari which is located very close to Nava Jeevan Home. The meet was attended by 23 adoptive families. The Chairperson of Child Welfare Committee, North 24 Parganas holding charge of Kolkata District attended the meet. Dr. Shashi Panja, Hon'ble Minister of State (Independent Charge), Department of Women and Child Development and Social Welfare, Government of West Bengal graced the occasion and interacted with the children and the families attending the meet. The children living in Nava Diganta Home, some of the children in Nava Jeevan Home took part in the small cultural programme that was organized. Karitas Sumati Árnadóttir who was born 26 September 1994 and adopted through us in Iceland attended the meet. The children attending the event with their parents also presented songs and dances. The children enjoyed themselves thoroughly. A simple lunch was organized for all our guests.

Nava Jyoti Nilgunj celebrated its 25th Anniversary on the 22nd of February 2019. The children of the crèche, coaching class and children-in-family put up a big show at the Barrackpore Municipality Hall (Sukanta Sadan). A. CRECHES RUN BY ISSA

ISSA is running crèches in Mominpur and Thakurpukur in Kolkata, Nilgunj in North 24 Parganas and Bara Andulia in Nadia district. We also support coaching class in the vocational training in Chetla. Projects are coordinated with Project Coordinators and they continue to do a good job. National Days are celebrated in the crèches and coaching classes.

- Central Adoption Resource Information & Guidance System (CARINGS) is the only official portal of CARA for legal Adoption Process.

- Under section 80 & 81 of Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015, any person or agency who indulges in illegal adoption shall be punished.
- By adopting a child illegally, you may unintentionally become part of child trafficking network.
- Adoption is a socio-legal process and there is no role of touts/middlemen in adoption as they may mislead you to adopt a child illegally.
